


Section II: Integrated Test 綜合測驗

World Heritage Sites are places in the world which are extremely significant from a cultural or natural perspective. These places are selected by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO). In order for a site to <u>31</u> on the World Heritage List, it must meet specific criteria. For instance, one cultural criterion is that the site should be a distinguished example of a traditional human settlement or of land-use which is representative of a culture or of human interaction with the environment. One natural criterion is that the site should contain superlative natural phenomena or areas of exceptional natural beauty and aesthetic importance. The inscription of a property on the World Heritage List is not only recognition of its outstanding universal value and integrity but also recognition of the need to protect and manage it. <u>32</u>, the World Heritage List includes 1052 properties, of which 814 are cultural, 203 natural and 35 mixed sites.

World Heritage Sites indeed have made the tourism industry explode at a remarkable rate. <u>33</u>, the rapid growth of tourism over recent decades has turned out to be both a challenge and an opportunity. On the one hand, tourism development at such sites can have crucial implications for their protection as well as the potential to bring about economic benefits supporting site conservation and the local economy; but on the other hand, poorly managed and uncontrolled tourism can have severe consequences on the site's integrity, <u>34</u> its value and impede long-term financial development. Thus the demand for a sustainable approach to planning and administration of tourism is inevitable. When site managers and government authorities collaborate with local communities, tourism can be advantageous to sites and citizens alike, enhancing economic growth <u>35</u> addressing preservation needs and reinforcing the identity and well-being of local communities. When managed effectively, tourism allows communities to flourish and sites to remain intact.




Text 1

The world's movie capital is not Hollywood but Bollywood. "Bollywood" refers to Hindi-language cinema produced in Mumbai (formerly Bombay). The name "Bollywood" is a portmanteau derived from Bombay and Hollywood, the center of the American film industry. However, unlike Hollywood, Bollywood does not exist as a physical place. Bollywood's film production center is a government-owned studio facility known as "Film City" in the northern suburbs of Mumbai. It is important to note that "Bollywood" is a term often misused to **encompass** all Hindi films, when in fact it only refers to movies produced in the region of Mumbai. Bollywood is the largest film producer in India and one of the largest centers of film production in the world.


Bollywood plots tend to be melodramatic. They frequently use formulaic ingredients such as unfortunate lovers and angry parents, love triangles, family ties, sacrifices, corrupt politicians, kidnappers, villains, siblings separated by fate, and convenient coincidences.

Dialogues in Bollywood films are usually not written in adorned Hindi so that they can be understood by the largest possible audience. There has been a growing presence of Indian English in the dialogue and songs as well. Bollywood films are mostly musicals, and are expected to contain catchy music, usually a mixture of Indian and Western music.

Bollywood is the world's most prolific film-producing center. Although one hundred and fifty U.S. films arrived in India in 1998, only the blockbuster *Titanic* has ever made India's top five list. Indian films have also become an international obsession. The cinema's global audience is estimated at between 3 and 4 billion–half of the planet.


Text 2

Have you ever wondered what it would be like to know how much pain someone is experiencing? Or have you ever tried to send a telepathic message to a partner in transit to "buy me a cup of coffee on your way home"?

In a recent interview, Facebook CEO Mark Zuckerberg boldly said: "One day, I believe we'll be able to send full rich thoughts to each other directly using technology. You'll just be able to think of something and your friends will immediately be able to experience <u>it</u> too if you'd like. This would be the ultimate communication technology." Will this fanciful idea of brain-to-brain communication come true some day?


From a purely technical standpoint, it is possible to "read" a person's brain activity and get a sense of what that person is thinking. When electrodes are attached to the scalp, or implanted into the brain, they can reveal something about brain activity. But reading the signals is one thing; decoding them is another. The way a person experiences thinking involves many parts of the brain operating simultaneously. **Picking up** all the signals that make up a thought in the brain would require sticking electrodes into lots of different areas. With the computing power available today, scientists could probably make sense of this complex pattern of electrical signals. However, a person's thoughts are more than just the simple sum total of voltage and current.

Nobody can predict exactly what patterns might be linked to a given set of thoughts. Stocco, a research scientist at the University of Washington who took part in the motor cortex experiment, was somewhat optimistic about Zuckerberg's vision though. "His scenario is far, but not unreachable," he said. "We could get there, given adequate work and knowledge."
